The admission procedure consists of the following two main applications:

1. **NMU application:** please send us the Master Shipping and Transport application form which is attached in this email and can be downloaded as well from the website [www.stc-nmu.eu](http://www.stc-nmu.eu). Successful candidates will receive a Letter of (provisional) Admission from NMU;
2. **NFP application:** with the Letter of (provisional) Admission from NMU you can apply for the NFP fellowship by presenting a completed NFP master's degree programme application form to the Netherlands embassy or consulate in your country. The application should be submitted well before the deadline for applications set by the embassy or consulate. 
**Note the general deadline at the Embassy or Consulate in February 2010!**
